Training required: All DDA mandated training, including CPR, First Aid, and Mandt.




**DELTA VARIANT: WHAT WE KNOW**

- The Delta variant is more contagious:
  - Some data suggest the Delta variant might cause more severe illness than previous strains in unvaccinated persons.
  - Unvaccinated people remain the greatest concern.
  - The greatest risk of transmission is among unvaccinated people who are much more likely to contract, and therefore transmit the virus.
  - Fully vaccinated people with Delta variant breakthrough infections can spread the virus to others. However, vaccinated people appear to be infectious for a shorter period
- Vaccines continue to reduce a person’s risk of contracting the virus that cause COVID-19, including this variant.
- For such people, the vaccine still provides them strong protection against serious illness and death.

- At this time, as we build the level of vaccination nationwide, we must also use all the prevention strategies available, including masking indoors in public places, to stop transmission and stop the epidemic.

When can I get a COVID-19 vaccine booster?  
 Not immediately. The goal is for people to start receiving a COVID-19 booster shot beginning in the fall, with individuals being eligible starting 8 months after they received their second dose of an mRNA vaccine (either Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna).
